



Women In Tech Statistics

Women currently hold only 26.7% of tech related jobs. Tech firms with more than 10,000 employees report women's representation at 26.2%. The percentage of women in all tech-related careers has actually decreased over the last 2 years. Women in software engineering report a lack of equal pay, making 0.93 cents for every dollar that men in the field make. Despite equal access, the percentage of women pursuing STEM subjects in higher education is on the decline, and women achieve just 18% of new computer science degrees. Companies that implement voluntary gender equality training for recruitment practices, hire fewer women than companies that implement mandatory training.

More than 50% of women in tech report gender inequality, discrimination, or sexual harassment in environments dominated by men. In prior years, women have received as little as 2% of all investment funds in a given year and receive far less global venture capital funding than men.



Women In Tech Statistics

The pandemic worsened many of the significant challenges that women face, with over 50% of women reporting difficulties due to pandemic workplace changes. Companies that perform intersectional pay audits hire women at 1.3 times the rate of other companies.







PAMPHLET MADE FOR MENSTRUATION AWARENESS

Menstruation(माहवारी या मासिक धर्म)

मासिक धर्म को माहवारी, रजोधमें, भैस्ट्रअल साइकिल या एमसी और पीरियइस के नाम से भी जाना जाता है। महिलाओं के शरीर में हामीन में होने वाले बदलाव की वजह से गर्भाशय से स्कत और अंदरूनी हिस्से से होने वाली स्वाव को मासिक धर्म कहते हैं। मासिक धर्म सबको एक ही उम में नहीं होता। लड़कियों को यह 8 से 17 वर्ष तक ही उम में हो सकता हैं।

मातिक धर्म शुरू कैसे होता है: जब कोई लड़की किशोरावस्था में पहुंचती है लब उसके अंडाशय इस्ट्रोजन एवं धोजेस्ट्रोन नामक हामीन उत्पन्न करने लगते हैं। इन हामीन की वजह से हर महीने में एक बार गर्भाशय की परत मोटी होने लगती है। कुछ अन्य हामीन अंडाशय को एक अनिषेचित डिम्ब उत्पन्न एवं उत्सर्जित करने का संकेत देते हैं। सामान्यतः अगर लड़की माहवारी के आसपास यौन संबंध नहीं बनाती हैं तो गर्भाशय की वह परत जो मोटी होकर गर्भावस्था के लिए तैयार हो रही थी, टूटकर रक्तसाव के रूप में बाहर निकल जाती है। इसे मासिक धर्म कहते हैं।

मासिक चक्र की वजह से ऐसे हार्मीन बनते हैं जो शरीर को स्वस्थ रखते हैं। हर महीने ये हार्मीन शरीर को गर्भधारण के लिए तैयार कर देते हैं।

मासिक धर्म या माहवारी आने से पहले महिला के शरीर में कुछ लक्षण दिखाई पडते हैं।

जैसे- माहवारी से पहले पेट में दर्द और ऐंठन की समस्या।



मासिक चक्र:-मासिक चक्र के दिन की गिनती पीरियड्सशुरु होने के पहले दिन से अगली पीरियड्सशुरु होने के पहले दिन तक की जाती है। लड़िकयों में मासिक चक्र 21 दिन से 45 दिन तक का हो सकता है। महिलाओं को मासिक चक्र 21 दिन से 35 दिन तक का हो सकता है। सामान्य तौर पर मासिक चक्र 28 दिन का होता है।

कब समाप्त होते हैं: महिलाओं में आमतौर पर मासिक धर्म रजोनिवृति तक की अविध तक होते हैं। रजोनिवृति आमतौर पर 50 वर्ष की आयु के आसपास या 45 और 55 वर्ष की आयु के बीच होती है। रजोनिवृत्ति का मतलब होता है कि एक महिला अब अंडाणु पैदा नहीं कर पायेगी (अंडे का उत्पादन नहीं कर पाना) या अब गर्भवतौ नहीं हो सकती है। इसकी तरह, रजोनिवृति महिला - महिला में भिन्न हो सकती है और यह परिवर्तन कई वर्षों तक हो सकता है।




